Learn a bit about Tiger Salamander



Size: 6 to 13 ½ inches long
What to look for: bulky body; broad head; small eyes; highly variable color and pattern (may include light or dark markings)
Habitat: diverse; from arid plains to high-elevation forests

Wildflower of the week



Spotted Coralroot

Size: 8 to 30 inches tall; flower ½ inch wide
Habitat: open woods, slopes
What to look for: flowers purplish, with purple spots on ruffled white lip, in wand-like cluster at top of purple to yellowish leafless stalk
In bloom: April through September
