Activity: Make a Stained Glass Animal

Things you will need:

- Newspaper
- Bottle of glue
- Black construction paper
- Scissors
- Tissue paper in different colors
- White crayon



Here's what to do:

Spread the newspaper over your work area. Draw the outline of your favorite animal onto the black construction paper using the white crayon. Also draw designs on your animal like spots, stripes, or even feathers or fur. Using the scissors, cut out your animal along the outline, then cut out each of the designs you drew on your animal, so the animal looks holey.



Next, cut out shapes from the tissue paper that are bigger than the designs on your animal. Put glue around each hole on the back side of the animal and stick a piece of tissue paper to the glue. Let the glue dry. Using masking tape, tape your stained glass animal to the window so the light can shine through the tissue paper.

Learn a bit about Great Horned Owl



- Size:** 18 to 24 inches tall
- What to look for:** large size; widely spaced ear tufts; mottled brown above, lighter below, with fine dark barring.
- Habitat:** scrub areas, woodlands, deserts, canyons, bottomlands.
- Comments:** The Great Horned Owl's calls are many and various, but the most common one is a series of muffled hoots: hoo, hoo-hoo, hoooo-hoo.

Wildflower of the Week



Queen's Cup Lily
(Clintonia uniflora)

- Size:** 3 to 5 inches tall; flower 1 to 2 inches wide
- Habitat:** rich woods, mountain slopes, thickets
- What to look for:** Flowers white with 6 petals in the shape of an open bell atop a leafless stem; 2 to 3 oval leaves at base; a round blue berry develops in the fall.
- In bloom:** July through September
